

CEHRS Tuition for 2021-22 School Year

Welcome to Congregation Etz Hayim's Religious School! Please read this document carefully and direct your questions to Laura Naide, Director of Religious Education at school@etzhayim.net.

- What does tuition cover?
 - Your tuition covers most of the expenses of running an excellent Religious School, including teacher salaries, books, online resources, supplies, security, field trips, Junior Congregation, and guest speakers. CEH is strongly committed to Jewish education and subsidizes the remaining school costs. The school also receives support from the CEH Men's Club, the CEH Sisterhood, and CEH endowment funds.
 - Tuition also covers weekly individual and small group Hebrew tutoring sessions for students in Grades 2-6 in addition to Religious School classes.
 - Youth Group activities for students in Grades 1-8.
- When is tuition due?
 - Tuition is due upon billing. If you would like to set up a payment plan, please contact our bookkeeper at accounting@etzhayim.net.
- What is the difference between Member and Non-Member tuition?
 - For the 2021-22 school year, non-members may enroll their students in our Religious School. This option is available to families who were not members during the 2020-21 school year. We think you'll try our school and you'll love it!
 - The non-member option is available for one school year. For example, if you enroll in 2021-22 as a non-member, you will need to become a member to continue in the 2022-23 school year.
 - If you enroll as a non-member, and one or more of your children is in 6th Grade or above, we require a meeting with our Rabbi in regard to Bar/Bat Mitzvah preparation. You need to be a member in order to hold a Bar/Bat Mitzvah ceremony at CEH.
- Will Religious School be held online or in-person during the 2021-22 School Year?
 - We plan to be 100% in person for Religious School classes during the 2021-22 school year. We will follow health and safety protocols of federal, state and local authorities as well as CEH's Reopening Committee.
 - Individual and small group Hebrew tutoring sessions will be held online.
 - We are prepared to pivot online if needed for health and safety reasons.

** Kitah Chet is billed in two installments. The first amount (\$600/\$900) covers tuition. The remaining \$500 pays for an overnight trip in the Spring. It will only be billed if we can travel safely and the amount may be lower depending on trip costs.
